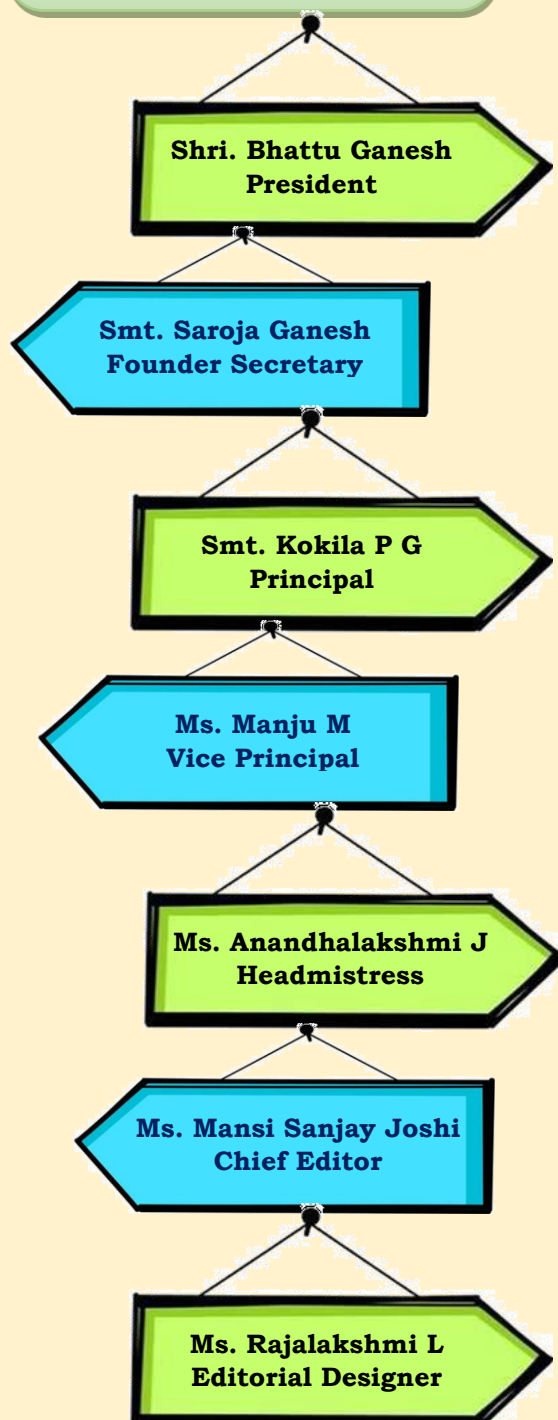

TEACHERS' ORIENTATION PROGRAM: - 05-2026 to 22-05-2026



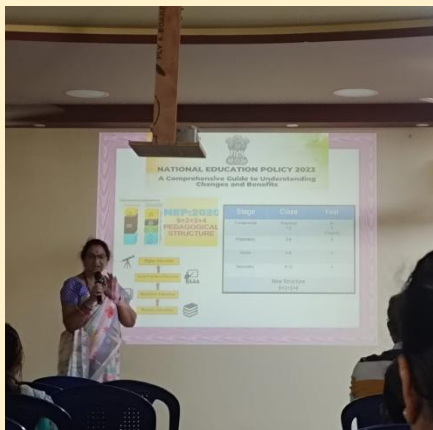

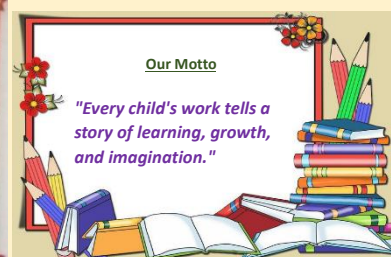

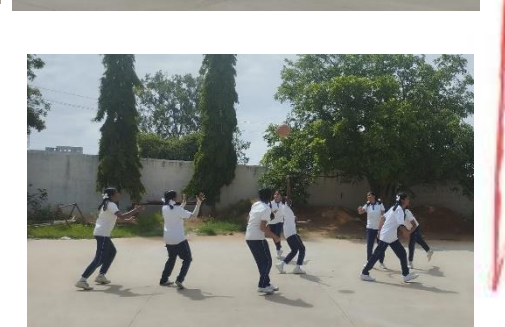
INTER HOUSE BASKETBALL COMPETITION – STD VII & VIII GIRLS
